- Review of Minutes: October's "Minutes" were approved unanimously.
- Hui 20 ac. Bike/walking Path Update: Trail work will be done on Sunday, Nov. 27th this month; for any Albezia trees we cut, and plan to use for trail bumpers(holding cinder/etc.), we plan to cut them into 5 foot lengths and put them on smaller branches to dry and be ready for placement. A possible alternative to cutting some Albezia trees in the area, is to use Milestone chemical injections.
- PATHS Hawaii Report: Dean S. gave an update on the latest project his group is now involved in. Bike Share Hawaii (a Canadian company), who already has a bike sharing program running on Oahu, is partnering with PATHS Hawaii and Hawaii County to develop the bike sharing program in the Hilo area. Dean S. will be heading up the project for PATHS Hawaii.
- Next Steps for HPPOA PATHS Committee: Materials to be used for 17th Street Hui trail; bobcat/small tractor for spreading materials; Councilman Ilagan's help in getting Equipment Operator's Union to help on trail;
