The road crew is finishing up the grading and laying down of materials on the ABC roads and up to 5th street. After that section is done they will be prepping 22nd Makuu dead end for Aggrebind. The striping project is still scheduled to begin in December 2018. The county has started the removal of Abandoned vehicles for private streets again which is good news for us because it was costing the association a lot of money to have them removed.

Liens: The office has processed 90 of the 299 property liens this fiscal year in support of our bond agreement.

Equipment: The parts are in for the Volvo grader. The repairs will start next week. All other equipment is running fine at this time.

Mowing: The road crew mowed 30 miles of roadway easement with the side arm mower and 55 miles with the deck mower.

Graded & Compacted: The road crew has graded 21.5 miles of road.

Signs: Dust emission signs have been placed on Makuu, Paradise and Kaloli.

Rubbish Pickup: 1.75 Tons of rubbish picked up.

Abandon Vehicles: 6 Vehicles removed.

Safety Report: No accidents or injuries for the past 48 months.
