

Halloween in Paradise Membership Committee August 29, 2018 Meeting Minutes

The Meeting was called to order at 12:12 pm on Wednesday August 29, 2018 by Kathy Crawford.

Meeting Minutes from August 15, 2018 were approved.

Tricia ordered the Twister game and it is on the way. She decided to make balloon pumpkins and will let the kids draw faces on them with sharpies.
