GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT FOR APRIL 2022

The ballots for the upcoming election were processed and mailed out on the 27th of April.

Hokori Construction is working on the paving project for 18th Ave between Makuu and Paradise. They should be starting the paving part of the project by the end of this week or the first part of next week.

The street number signs were dropped off at the machine shop to get the holes drilled in for mounting to the signpost. Should be ready next week sometime.

Equipment: The John Deere sidearm mower is down for repairs. Waiting for parts. Should be here in a week or so. All other equipment is running fine at this time. The road crew continues to do daily maintenance on all equipment.

Mowing: The road crew mowed 121 miles of roadway easement with the sidearm mower and 61 miles with the deck mower.

Grading: Widened, dropped 1 ½" base course and compacted approximately 7.5 miles of roadway. Beach KDE, 16 KDE, 17 KDE, 18 KDE, 19 KDE, 20 KDE, 20 MP25 MDE, 32 PKDE. Widened, graded, and compacted approximately 3 miles of roadway. 33 MDE, 31 MDE, 30 MDE, 28 MDE, 26 MDE, 24 MDE.

Hot Mix: Filled holes with hot mix on Pohaku Circle, 31 KS, Kaloli Main, 27 KS, 26 PK, 26 MP, Makuu Main between 23-24.

Weedwacking: Corners of Ala Heiau, Alphabets, Paradise, and Kaloli Main, Loke to 10th.

Rubbish Pickup: 1.35 tons of mixed rubbish, 1.48 tons of scrap metal.

Dead Animals: Removed 3 pigs

Abandoned Vehicles: 9 vehicles removed

Safety Report: No accidents or injuries for the past 89 months
