General Manager's Report for April 2018 – Submitted by Don Morris

Thank you for all the incoming road maintenance request. The road crew continues the ongoing daily grading of unpaved roadways to try and catch up with all the potholes created by the past rains. We seem to be in a better weather pattern now. Hopefully it will last for awhile so the road crew can make better progress on the grading of the roads.

Aggrebind: The order of Aggrebind has arrived and has been unloaded into our warehouse. The Aggrebind representative for our project is currently out of the country until May 22. He will be sending us a schedule of his arrival when he returns to the mainland.

Equipment: We are still waiting to replace the clutch master cylinder on the Volvo grader. They sent us the wrong one. We are still waiting for the right one. All other equipment is running fine at this time. We continue to do the daily maintenance and repairs on all other equipment.

Mowing: The road crew mowed 40 miles of roadway easement with the side arm mower and 42 miles with the deck mower.

Widen, graded, graveled and compacted 14 miles of road.

Fill Potholes with AC hot mix: 23M-P, 24M-P, 24P-K, 25M-P, 26M-P, 26P-K, 27K-S, P-20, PHC

Trees Cut and Removed: 2 K-Dead end, 3 K-Dead end, 18 M-Dead end, RR dead end

Rubbish Pickup: 1.75 Tons

Dead Animals Removed: 4 pigs

Abandoned Vehicles: Six tagged vehicles from last month still remain.

Safety Report: No accidents or injuries for the past 44 months.
