GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 2022

The road crew has installed the flashing stop signs at the bottom of Makuu, Paradise, and Kaloli along with arrow and red end of road signs.

I picked up the new signs for the board and membership meetings this past Monday. The road crew will be installing them soon. The speed limit signs are also in. The road crew will be installing them in between all their other work.

Equipment: The John Deere side arm mower is still in the shop. It may be done by the end of the first part of the next week. The deck mower is down. Hopefully it will be back up in a few days. The water truck is also having issues not sure what the problem is yet. Other than that, all other equipment is running fine at this time.

Grading: Widened, dropped, 1 ½" base course and compacted 2 miles of roadway. Lemiwai, 4 MP, 4 MDE. Widened, graded, and compacted 7 miles of roadway. 21 PK, 20KDE, 18 PK, 16 MDE, 6 MP, 6 PK, Loki, and the Alphabets.

Weedwacking: Corners, on Makuu, Paradise and Kaloli, Shower and Alphabets.

Mowing: The road crew mowed 42 miles of roadway with the deck mower.

Hot Mix: Filled holes with hot mix on Kaloli, Makuu, 33 MDE, 32 MDE, 26 MP, and 26 PK.

Signs Replaced: Stop Signs 32 M, 29 M, 27 M, 25 M, 23 M, 21 M, 17 P, AND 11 M.

Roads Watered: 49 miles of roadway watered.

Dead Animals: 7 pigs removed

Rubbish Pickup: 1.08 tons of mixed rubbish.
