

GM Report for August 16th, 2023

ROADS:

Trash costs – 1.98 Tons of Rubbish hauled, and 1.26 tons of scrap metal and tires disposed of at a cost of \$524.65
Animals – Three dead pigs and One goat has been disposed of

Signs – Replaced: 2 Stop signs, and 1 Dead-end sign

Roads Graded and Rolled: 15 Miles

15th Maku'u Dead-end, 21st Maku'u Dead-end to 21st Paradise and Kaloli, 17th Maku'u Dead-end to 17th Kaloli Dead end.

Total Roads rocked-2739.56 Tons at a cost of \$49,247.52

21st Maku'u Dead-end to Paradise to Kaloli, and 17th Maku'u Dead-end to Kaloli Dead-end

Total Asphalt: 8.04 Tons at a cost of \$1,316.78

25th Maku'u to Paradise, 26th Paradise to Kaloli, 23rd Maku'u to Paradise, and 22nd Paradise to Kaloli

Side Arm Mower Returned to operational status on the 19th of July. In preparation for school starting and safety concerns, it has been clearing the view of each road as you enter the Main drives to provide better visibility. We only have one Side arm mower, so getting control of the cane grass on the easements is tricky. The grass tends to grow faster than we can cut it. I'd like to see another side arm mower in the CIP sooner rather than later. Possibly on this years CIP if we can push a purchase to next year.

Roads Watered: 68 miles of roads watered.

Paving: CIVIL Construction has finish at Pohaku and we are still awaiting the striping and box reflectors

Personnel Items:

A new Non-roads employee has been hired and is doing well.

Equipment:

We purchased the new diesel zero turn mower from Bacon Universal and installed necessary safety equipment on it. It is now in use around Hawaiian Paradise Park. The new Shop truck has been purchased as well from Big Island Motors. We are awaiting a board vote on the medium sized dump truck. The Case Grader needs new tires, and we received a quote to order and purchase.

Misc.

Work has commenced to safely store all the archived files for HPPOA. We now have a secured, climate-controlled storage area for these files so that we can safely have them with less degradation. The office files have been transferred. The shop files have been cleaned and are in the process of being categorized and transferred.
