

GM Report for October 18th, 2023

ROADS:

Trash costs – 2.55 Tons of Rubbish hauled disposed of at a cost of \$379.95 Animals – One dead pig has been disposed of

Signs – Installed: (1) Dead-end sign, (6) 25MPH signs, and (3) 15MPH signs.

Roads Graded and Rolled and Rocked: 2.5 Miles

Easement Maintenance:

Personnel Items:

The part-time accountant position has been advertised and we are starting to receive applications for the position.

Equipment:

The new medium sized dump truck has been ordered and should arrive in the next 30-45 days. It was already completed the installation of the dump bed and hydraulics, and we are just waited for it to ship. The side by side is still down as we are awaiting the parts to come in for it to be fixed. Still awaiting the new engine for the old backhoe, but we are able to use it for miscellaneous jobs until then. We have begun looking for a second side arm mower, however, finding one under our budget in the local area has not produced any results. The search continues outside the local area. We have a line on a Used Water truck, but we are seeing if the previous owner is going to part with it, so that we can start the inspection process. It is under our budget and located in Kona.
