### **ROADS:**

**Trash costs** – 2.52 Tons of Rubbish and 15 tires hauled and disposed of at a cost of \$569.92

Animals – Five dead pigs has been disposed of

**Signs – Installed:** (2) Blind Hill signs, (1) 25MPH signs

**Roads Graded and Rolled and Rocked:** 4.5 Miles
