

GM Report for December 20th, 2023

ROADS:

Trash costs – 1.6 Tons of Rubbish hauled and disposed of at a cost of \$238.40

Animals – Seven dead pigs, two cats, and one sheep has been disposed of

Signs – Installed: (2) Slow, (2) 25MPH signs, and (2) Child at Play, Drive slow signs installed.

Roads Graded and Rolled and Rocked: 5.5 Miles

3,253.52 Tons at a cost of \$59,645.58

9th Kaloli Dead-end, 9th Kaloli to Paradise, 15th Kaloli Dead-end, 15th Kaloli to Paradise, 15th Paradise to Maku'u, 8th Maku'u Dead-end, and 8th Maku'u to Paradise, and 3 Loads to the Shop to be used for spot dropping in Potholes around the park.

Easement Maintenance:

Maku'u and 11th has been addressed on the Paho side of Maku'u. This area turned into a lake during the last downpour and needed to be remedied immediately. We are working on the Keaau side, and on the top of 11th Maku'u dead-end as soon as our Backhoe hammer is repaired.

Roads Watered: 31 Miles We had a very wet month of November so water calls were down.

Equipment:

The new medium sized dump truck is in and we should be seeing it around the park shortly. The side by side is back up and fixed. We are still waiting for the new engine for the old backhoe however we have been notified that it has shipped and will be here shortly. We are still looking for a second side arm mower. Just the cost for a mulching head, boom and setup is around \$85,000. The search continues outside the local area. We were able to look at multiple Water trucks, however, they were in need of repairs and did not fit our needs.

Misc:

We have all the necessary equipment needed to do a test run of Calcium Chloride on a stretch of gravel road, however, the weather is not cooperating with us. We have scheduled it for multiple days, but rains have caused us to postpone the test until the conditions improve.
