**Misc:**

The financial reports have been sent out as of the 9<sup>th</sup> of August and it should have reached the residents by now. Striping is complete on Maku'u Main Drive, Paradise Main Drive, Kaloli Main Drive and Shower Drive. The reflectors will be installed shortly. Work continues on the mail box sites. The USPS has completed the installation of the mailboxes on the 4<sup>th</sup> site, and the 6<sup>th</sup> and Maku'u site soon pending the addition of more boxes. They are currently moving boxes from the Hilo site, to HPP to facilitate a quick installation once the schematics are issued. Keys will not be issued to the public for the boxes until all four sites are completed per the USPS, and this is to facilitate the routes and assignments of the boxes. I have just gotten back from California where we inspected and purchased a water truck. We are expecting it to arrive by the end of the month. Our website has been updated to inform the local Organic farmers, that if they do not want their road in front of their property with Calcium Chloride, to contact the office to be placed on the "Do Not Spray" list.
