Every gravel road had new gravel put on it last Fiscal Year, and the road crew has been ambitiously working on getting ahead of schedule for maintenance. They were able to Grade, rock, and compact approximately 16 miles of roadway last month. The activity center water pump has been causing issues with water being provided to the bathrooms. We have a plumber working on the issue however we are awaiting a part to come in. We are getting ready for the next mass mailings which should be going out in the mail at the end of this month. I am not projecting on needing any volunteers, however, should this change, I will send out a notification.
