

Presidents Report

October 16, 2024

The annual audit is underway, the audit team arrived on Monday October 14th and will be here all week. The office staff continue to pull and provide requested items for them as needed. We are now at 80% of our owners paid in full.

The paving of Ala Heiau has begun, the north end from Makuu to Beach has been paved. The contractor has been preparing the south side of Ala Heiau, but a shortage of asphalt has delayed the paving and completion. Hokori Construction will continue paving when materials becomes available. Please keep traffic to a minimum where they are working.

Blessing ceremonies were held October 1st at all 4 mail park sites and were well attended by members. The beautification committee has a workday scheduled for October 19th at 4th and Kaloli site. They plan to weed the site and plant new plants. Meetings with USPS were delayed, no update as of the writing of this report.

The road crew has applied the Calcium Chloride in front of the owner's homes that requested it. They will continue this process throughout the year every few months as requests are received.

We are excited to have our new to HPP water truck here and servicing our roads. A used side arm mower was purchased last week and will be shipped over from the mainland soon. Both these items will help the road crew work more efficiently.

Thanks to Jeff Finley for filling in for me while I was on the mainland the past 3 weeks with family.

Please continue to report road issues that you see to the office so they can be addressed quickly. All other issues, please call the police for noise complaints, fireworks or speeding.
