Meeting Minutes

Location: Library/Zoom

- Meeting called to order at 11:11am by Jeanette.
- Present: Kari Hoffman, Keith Redman, Jeanette Baysa. Absent: Ray Sims, Katherine Patton
- Agenda approved as amended Motion by Kari, 2nd by Keith. Unanimous vote.
 - A. Add item H to old business.
- Minutes approved for 02/10/25. Motion by Kari, 2nd by Keith. Unanimous vote.

- Unfinished Business
 - A. Progress report on 4th & Kaloli: weed mitigation from parking area closest to 4th continues. It is almost complete. Discussion held on 'rolling' the gravel area to allow for painting of the parking lanes. Work to continue on the back parking area next and continue to maintain the front area. The use of a propane torch to kill the small weeds popping up is proving to be efficient.
 - B. Progress report on 6th & Maku'u: Cinder was delivered on Tuesday, and spreading will be done on the next work party March 16th.
 - C. Mulch for 4th and 6th: Keith and Kari continue to get mulch and spread it in the area fronting Kaloli, to make it more level, filling in the uneven areas. He also brings mulch to the 6th/Maku'u site.
 - D. Review March Schedule: Mar 2, Mar 16 (6th/Maku'u); Mar 8, Mar 22 (4th/Kaloli)
 - E. Sign schedule for placement: Keith is in charge of maintaining the signs and getting them placed at the sites a week before a scheduled work party. He indicated that the stands are not holding up to the winds, and the signs end up laying down. He will work on figuring out a solution.
 - F. Laying boxes for 6th: Keith has heard from 2 community members that they don't want laying boxes. Presumed they would rather pick eggs from the ground in scattered places. Will pend for now.
 - G. Gravel for 6th: There is a corner of the parking area that is a dangerous drop off and the committee recommends that additional gravel be used to mitigate a safety issue. Kari will take this to the BOD as needed. Pend for now.
 - H. Revisit design for 4th/Kaloli: Jeanette brought up revisiting some design for the 4th/Kaloli site. Katherine suggests that red cinder be brought and laid in 3 spots in the area fronting Kalili. Using different shapes doesn't have to be circular. Discussion ensued with ideas as to where, and how. Perhaps lay some surrounding the *ohi'a* trees or connect them (eventually) with a walking path. Suggested the next time we are on site, that we come up with 3 areas and mark them.
