

Mail Park Update

February 22, 2026

11 additional parcel lockers were installed at 4th and Kaloli on Nov 20th, there will be 3 additional parcel lockers installed as soon as weather permits. The locks for 6th & Maku'u have arrived and the holes drilled for the 5 additional CBUs and the 17 parcel lockers. They will be installed as soon as weather permits.

USPS is in the process of resequencing the entire mail park at 6th and Makuu prior to its opening. It is vital for the addresses to be in order to give the carrier the ability to deliver efficiently. The 5 additional CBUs with 8 boxes each are ready to be installed in addition to the 17 parcel lockers once the rain stops. That being said, it will most likely be 30 – 60 days before the 6th & Maku'u mail park will open.

The Postmaster is checking on the service contract for 6th & Maku'u to see if it was submitted yet or not. If not, she will prepare it and submit it to the contract department to go out for bid.

Once the master locks are received for 14th & Kaloli mail park, they will start to install the CBUs at that site.

Be on the lookout for banners on the roads letting you know when keys will be available for these locations. Key distribution hours and locations will be posted on the website and Facebook Page to get the word out as well.

The mail park at 16th & Maku'u will be done last. We have learned that opening one mail park at a time is best for everyone. We will keep you posted as each mail park gets closer to opening.

After all 4 mail parks are open, the post office will complete the project by removing the CBU's from the main roads and assign boxes to those on Pohaku Circle at the boxes located on the other side of the highway.
